NOTES

THE AGE OF FEAR

I want to leave you with four things to help you overcome fear:

1. Control what you can and leave the rest to God... Matt. 6:25-34, "do not worry about your life what you will eat or drink...look at the birds....consider the lilies of the field....if God takes care of them, won't He also care for you...but see first the kingdom of God..."
2. Realize God is in control, and God is able to bring good out of bad. 2 Timothy 1:7 "for God did not give us a spirit of fear..."
3. Realize that God has promised to never leave you or forsake you (Heb. 13:5).
4. Start right now to cultivate an eternal perspective...one that is not caged in by fear...but eternal. Realize also that many of our problems are not eternal.

The only way fear should rule and reign in your life today is if you have not experienced His love or you have overlooked or underestimated His love for you.
