VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

PRAYER - We are thankful for everyone that has been praying for this ministry effort. As VBS approaches, we are in need of more people to serve on the Prayer Team! This effort is crucial for success. Would you be willing to serve in this way? If so, see Pastor Russ.

VOLUNTEERS - We have need for more volunteers in other areas as well: grillers for the VBS meal after church on July 26th; servers for the food line that day; some extra people to help with the cleaning/sanitizing efforts each night; people to help pack the science experiment and help deliver to homes that have signed up for the live-stream; and we are in need of bottled water. REGISTRATION - If you know you are attending in person or participating online, please register now as it helps us prepare the at-home science experiments that go to every family. Registration is available in the foyer after worship.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES - We would like to implement a back-to-school outreach that starts the last night of VBS (July 30th). Our vision for this is to collect school supplies from now until Wed, July 29th (drop off is the Children's Ministry table in the foyer). Then on July 30th, we'll open a school supply station in the church that families can visit if they are in need of school supply assistance (this will stay open for a couple weeks or while supplies last). We encourage our church family to use these supplies as a way to reach out to neighbors and friends in the community. Each school supply bag will include ministry items and information about our church. Here are some general supplies for the stocking effort: **crayons, pencils, markers, colored pencils, zip lock bags, tissues, rulers, scissors, pencil top erasers, glue sticks, wide lined spiral notebooks, erasers, & dry erase markers.**

SPREAD THE WORD - The greatest promotion is still word of mouth and **personal invitation**. This event will change lives...I believe this! The question is, how many? With how engaging Josh's ministry is, this is a great opportunity to invite. The virtual option also opens the door to people who aren't quite ready to step into the church building. **Let's lean in hard here...there are people who need Jesus!**
